Special Deliveries!

We will be personally delivering school reports on Thursday and Friday. It will be a great opportunity for some staff and children to at least see each other (socially distanced of course).

The reports are different to other years:

- Years 1-6 are in the form of a letter to the individual child from the class teacher
- The results are based upon tests two weeks before Easter. **Therefore, the children were only two thirds of the way through the school year- had we had the 'normal' school year they may well have have a different mark.** We decided that it was best to leave it this way, rather than making predictions, as it will give a much more accurate starting point when children come back.
- Only Nursery children, of an age who are going up to Reception in September, receive the reports in the Early Years format

Year 6 will be focusing on preparing for secondary but equally important are different packs and info that is being prepared for Nursery children, or those coming to St George's for the first time. We will also be sharing which staff will be taking each class.
