

Reminders/Notes for Monday March 8th

- Children need to be in uniform please (which means black shoes and/or black trainers)
- The arrangements in school will be the same for now- class bubbles won't mix
- We won't be temperature checking- it hasn't proved effective so this is a good time to stop. However, Hands, Face, Space will remain crucial
- Please remember re general lockdown rules- we all want this to be the return, no more sending children home
- Coming in and out of school will be the same- children need to be dropped off at gate. Masks must be worn by adults unless medically exempt. If you aren't wearing one we will offer you a disposable mask out of courtesy
- Children will enter the same way as last time, between 8.40 and 8.55am
- Collection from school will be the same, but please remember if you can collect as near 3.15 the older your child is, the better. As a 'rough' rule: 3pm
Reception/Nursery/Dragons; 3.05 Years 1 and 2; 3.10 Years 3 and 4; and 3.15 Years 5 and 6. Please don't mix with other households on the playground
- We have returned to school so the usual rules re attendance apply

- Outdoor Learning will be on different mornings again. We have checked with the Local Authority and as we follow the guidelines we will start small local visits immediately.
- This time, we are able to bring in sports coaches. We are going to use them to deliver high quality physical education sessions to smaller groups while the other children have more time for recovery teaching with an adult **they already know and who knows them**
- Years 3, 4 and 5 have an after school club. Year 6 are being offered the free Easter Coaching in resilience and self-esteem as well as activities.

- Our Pastoral Team are always here to help you and your children. That remains the case. We will signpost any support needed
- There will be a lot of support regarding mental health as well as education in lessons and 1-1 where needed
- Next Christian Value- Liberty, then Forgiveness for Easter
- Planning a 'Design for Life' week in the Summer Term. This will focus on our 'Creativity' value and bring in Science, Engineering and The Arts
