Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to you to ask for your help in improving road safety outside our School. Whilst no-one can rule out accidents altogether, there is much we can do together to make the roads surrounding St George's School as safe as humanly possible.

Firstly, please do not park on the yellow lines/zig zags around School. The only vehicles allowed to do so are taxis and the School minibuses, for a very limited amount of time. I am aware that some of the markings are not as clear as they could be and I contacted the Council regarding this a few weeks ago. I do also intend to contact the local Police and traffic wardens to ask for their support in enforcing lawful parking.

Please also ensure your children are supervised when crossing busy streets on the way to School and, if they are cycling to School, they should be wearing a helmet. The School Council last week have also begun a competition for the children to design outdoor safety signs which will be placed as a reminder at different 'hotspots' outside School.

This week's assemblies, as always at this time of year, are already surrounding safety on darker nights and with Halloween approaching, common sense behaviour in the evenings. Please support us in this by discussing safety and sensible behaviour on darker nights with your child.

I will be outside in the morning with Mrs Chapman as much as possible in the mornings and am always available for a chat. I'm sure we can all work together to make the area around St George's School the safest it can possibly be for us all.
