We have had a discussion, both over the phone and on site with local managers on how best to manage parking fairly and sensibly. They have provided the correct cones for school to put out and have advised us how to proceed.

- 1) Where most important, we have coned off the double yellow lines
- 2) We have left a space for disabled badge holders only.
- 3) Taxis are allowed to wait in that space also
- 4) School will continue to request drivers move off double yellow lines if they aren't a taxi or have a blue badge
- 5) Police will prosecute parking on the zig-zags but the school minibus may pick up and drop off there.
