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Dear Parent/Carer,

This is just a short note to answer some frequently asked questions about our transition phase for the last two weeks. We look forward to seeing you there. If after this, you have any further questions at all, please contact the number above or ask the class teacher through Class Dojo.

Frequently asked questions:

**1) Do the children have to wear uniform?**

No, the transition days are non-uniform. Please just ensure they have the correct uniform ready to wear in September.

**2) My child has been attending in a 'bubble'. Do they still come in to school?**

No, the bubbles are finished for the year, children only come in on the transition day they have been given and no other day now. **THE ONLY EXCEPTION IS YEAR 6. YOU STILL COME IN THE SAME ENTRANCE, ON YOUR SAME ALLOTTED DAYS**

**3) Can brothers and sisters come on the same day?**

Only if they have the same transition day. We can only accommodate a certain number of children and adults to maintain social distancing.

**4) Does my child bring a packed lunch and a drink?**

Yes, unless they have been receiving Free School Meals, then they will receive their usual packed lunch. Please still bring a drink though.

**5) My child receives a free pack up and now they are at home. Will they still get delivered?**

Yes, deliveries will continue till we finish on July 17<sup>th</sup>. That will be the last day. Then those who are entitled will get a voucher for the summer. We will contact you about this.

**6) Does my child have to wear a face mask in school?**

No, they don't.

**7) Will there be a school bus pick up?**

No, there won't be.

**8) How many adults can come with the children?**

Only one I'm afraid. This will keep the social distancing and numbers correct.

**9) Can I bring my other children when I come to drop my child off?**

Yes, you can, although if at all possible try not to. You won't be able to come in to school and speak to the new teacher with them though, as we have to keep numbers down inside.

**10) What time will school open?**

The playground gate will open between 8.40am and 9am. There will be cones to stand at outside for each family, properly distanced.

**11) What happens then?**

We will filter each parent and child in to the playground. For each group, there will be coloured cones to stand at. There will be lots of staff there to help direct you. When we have most of the group, the children's 'old' teacher will take them to class.

You will have the opportunity, if you have time, to come and meet the new teacher and Mr Herbert in the hall, socially distanced and with hand hygiene measures in place. There will then be a short time with your child's new class teacher too.

**12) What about the end of the day?**

We do the same thing as the morning, in reverse. We will finish between 3 and 3.15 from Monday to Thursday and 2-2.15 on Friday.

**13) What about if my child is going into Nursery or Little Dragons?**

You have had an invitation and should know your own arrangements. If you are not sure, ring school to check.

**14) Will anything happen if I do/don't bring them?**

No, it is your choice, based on the information given to you.
