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Provision

- I understand that the provision is childcare and not a teaching classroom.
- I appreciate that should it become impossible for school to staff the provision, due to staff illness, self-isolation or shielding, then the childcare will cease with immediate effect and that this may be with very little notice.
- I will ensure my child enters the school through the designated entrance (School Playground) and they have been checked in.
- I will ensure my child is escorted to school by somebody who either has parental responsibility or has been nominated, as long as they are all fit and well and not showing symptoms of coronavirus.
- I will provide the school with a password in line with their safeguarding measures. I will ensure the nominated person collecting my child is provided with the password.
- I understand that no parent/carer will be allowed beyond the playground gate (unless in a medical emergency).
- I will inform school if I no longer fall within the critical worker list or I have been advised to self-isolate.

Health Risks

- I understand that the school and parents/carers need to undertake as stringent practice as possible to reduce the risks of transmission of the virus (and other illnesses).
- Social distancing must be enforced whilst their child is not attending school if we are to prevent/minimise the spread of infection. We cannot emphasise this enough. This is to keep other pupils and staff safe.
- I understand that the school is providing childcare and my child will play with other children.
- I recognise that it is impossible to limit my child's social contact with other children at school.
- I understand that the adults working in the school will try to maintain common sense in terms of social distancing whilst working with the children - however, they are caring for the children and therefore may work closer than 2 metres with them.
- I understand that whilst the school will endeavour to regularly clean the areas used and will engage in frequent hand washing, we are unable to guarantee a risk-free and virus-free school.

I will ensure that my child has high levels of hygiene and cleanliness to reduce risk of transmission, which includes thorough hand washing just before leaving the home and applying hand sanitiser on entering school

Clothing/Personal Items

- I will ensure that my child is wearing clothes appropriate for school (and trainers) every time they attend school.
- I will put clothes straight in the washing machine once returning home from school, to reduce the risk of transmission.
- I will ensure my child has a coat, water bottle and sun cream each day, giving consideration to the weather.
- I will ensure my child will not bring any items to the school from home with them except necessary medication (handed to member of staff on arrival).

Medication/Illness

- I will not bring my child to the school if they have any symptoms of coronavirus or if anyone in the household has symptoms. I will isolate my child and the whole household for 14 days if this is the case and will inform the school immediately.
- I will ensure that if my child has medication for asthma, allergies or other conditions, they bring medication with them every day in a labelled container.
- I understand that this medication will come home every day (in case the school has to close without notice). It is my responsibility to ensure that the medication is in date.
- I understand that if my child needs any other form of medication, I will need to complete a 'Medication Form' (available from the School Office). Administration of medication will need to be agreed by the Headteacher / senior leader on duty.
- I will inform the member of staff on arrival if I have given my child any medication e.g. Calpol, before they come to the school.
- I understand that if my child becomes unwell during their time in the school, they will be immediately placed in isolation (in accordance with government guidance) and I will be contacted and asked to collect them as soon as possible. If I can't be reached, the other contacts given will be called. I understand that the school staff will not have to prove or justify their decision about a child's illness.
- I understand that if my child falls dangerously ill the staff will contact medical services as well as contacting me.
- I agree that if I become unwell with coronavirus symptoms, I must immediately contact school and arrange for immediate collection of my child.

Personal Details

- I will ensure consent, that covers a variety of health and safety, information storing and information sharing, is signed.
- I will ensure the school has up to date emergency contact details, including other family members, in case my child becomes poorly/exhibits symptoms of coronavirus.
