Dear Parents/Carers

We have arranged for Year 4 to visit Brockhole Visitor Centre on Tuesday, 19th July. Your child will need the following:-

1. A lightweight coat.

4. A sun hat/cap and sun cream if the weather is hot on the day. It would be helpful if parents/carers could apply sun cream to their child before coming to school on the day.
5. A packed lunch and plenty to drink (non-fizzy please). If your child normally receives free school meals, then a packed lunch and a small drink will be provided by School. Please bring extra for your child to drink throughout the day (non-fizzy). If your child wishes to bring their own packed lunch then that is fine. At dinner time, the children will be eating outside 'picnic style' so let's hope the sun shines on the day!!
